




Q2 What is your child's current grade level?

Q3 What is the best way for us to get important information regarding school events or your child's progress to you? (Check all that apply)





Q4 How do you receive interim reports and report cards?





Q5 Please rate your overall experience with Brevard Public School's eLearning program.





Q6 What has been the biggest challenge with the eLearning environment?





Q7 Do you feel welcome at your child's school?





Q8 The office staff at my school is polite and is helpful in answering my questions or concerns.





Q9 In the past year, how often did you attend a parent meeting or event at your child's school that supported your child's academic success?













Q14 How often do you communicate with your child's teachers?





Q15 How often do your child's teachers communicate with you about your child's progress?





Q17 How often does your child's school or teachers provide you with information about ways you can help your child's learning at home?





Q19 What types of family engagement resources would you use if they were provided at your school?





Q20 Have you been given opportunities to provide input and feedback into school decisions (school improvement, Title I services, event planning, discipline)?




