## Summer 2019 Drivers Education Scholarship

The purpose of the Brevard Public School's Driver Education Scholarship Program is to provide an opportunity for students, who may need financial assistance, to participate in a professionally licensed Drivers Education Program.

To be eligible for consideration for the Summer 2019 Brevard Public Schools Driver Education Scholarship, an applicant must meet all of the minimum requirements listed below as well as submit all of the required documents. Students who apply **MUST**:

1. be a current student at a Brevard Public Schools' High School
2. be age 15, 16 or 17 years old at time of Application Submission
3. complete and submit all required forms and attachments listed below:
  - a. Driver's Education Scholarship Application Form
  - b. Driver's Education Essay

Students who receive free/reduced lunch, are homeless, or are in foster care will receive priority for this scholarship.

**Application Deadline- Tuesday May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019 3:00pm.**

**Applications should be submitted in one of following ways:**

- 1- **Mail** (US. Post) to the Office of Secondary Learning & Learning C/O Rachel Winsten, 2700 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Viera FL 32940 (if mailed, postmark must be by May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019)
- 2- **Dropped off** at the customer service desk at the ESF/School Board Office Building in Viera (2700 Judge Fran Jamieson Way). Write "ATTN: R. Winsten, Driver Education" on the envelope or cover page

Policies: Each scholarship granted will cover the \$120.00 fee associated with Drivers Education. Only ONE Scholarship may be granted per student. Application and required documents must be complete and submitted by the deadline for consideration.
