

Winter EOC Information

For your planning purposes, this notification contains important information concerning the upcoming End-of-Course (EOC) exams and MAP Progress Monitoring for math.

- Please be aware that all EOCs count as a final exam grade and **comprise 30% of course grades**.
- Students who do **not** complete an EOC will receive a grade of zero for the exam, which will adversely affect final grades and students' GPAs. Therefore, it is critically important that all students currently enrolled in these classes sit for EOC's. Please keep this in mind as you plan any holiday travel.
- All EOC's may only be taken **ONE** time. They may **NOT** be retaken for a higher score.

MAP Progress Monitoring:

- The second MAP assessment for students **currently** taking Algebra 1A, Algebra 1, Geometry, and Liberal Arts math will take place Dec. 7 – 8.
- E-Learners are required to participate on campus according to the Re-Opening agreement between BPS and the Florida DOE, and should check their teachers' messages for assessment locations.

Algebra EOC:

- The Algebra 1 retakes are scheduled for Nov. 30 – Dec. 3 for students who have taken Algebra 1 in **previous** terms but who have **not yet** taken **or** passed the EOC.
- Students who are **currently** taking Algebra 1 will sit for the EOC on Jan. 6 – Jan. 7 (please note this is an update).

Geometry, Biology, and U.S. History EOCs:

- Will be administered January 6 – January 15, 2021 for students who are currently enrolled in those classes.

Scholar Diploma Designation: Students who were **previously** enrolled in Geometry, Biology, and U.S. History during Spring, 2020 are exempted and therefore **not** required to take these EOCs for graduation. However, students who are striving to earn the Scholar Diploma designation **may** elect to take these exams, as passing **all** of them is part of the Scholar Diploma requirement. Other requirements of the Scholar Diploma include:

- Earn one credit in Algebra 2
- Earn one credit in Statistics or an equally rigorous mathematics course
- Earn one credit in Chemistry or Physics
- Earn one credit in an equally rigorous science course
- Earn two credits in the same world language
- Earn at least one credit in an AP or Dual Enrollment course.
- Students will still qualify for the Scholar Diploma without taking the EOCs for Biology and U.S. History if they take AP Biology or U.S. History and pass the AP exam with a 3 or higher

If you wish for your student who was enrolled in Geometry, Biology, and/or U.S. History in Spring, 2020 to take any of these EOCs in order to meet the Scholar Designation, *please sign up by Monday, December 7 at:*

Students will receive notifications regarding their EOC exams and MAP progress monitoring date(s), time(s), and location(s) through Focus messages. Lastly, final exams for courses that do **not** have an EOC are scheduled for January 14 – January 15. Course final exams comprise 20% of final grades, with Quarter 2 grades posting to Focus on January 21. Students who miss final exams should make arrangements with teachers to make-up tests as soon as possible, but prior to January 29, 2021.
