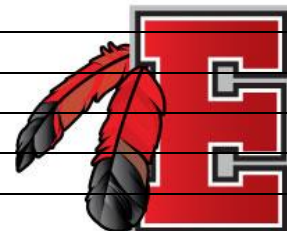

Update on Mascot Issue

After Edgewood's School Advisory Council (SAC) concluded its general business during the November 19 meeting, the group discussed the potential mascot name change from the Indian. This is the first time the SAC members have had the opportunity to share and discuss their insights into the issue. Having had time to review the public comments received in September and October, the group opened the floor to comments and questions from members; as ideas were expressed, they were recorded on a whiteboard to help facilitate discussion.

Please review the information below regarding the Take Stock in Children Scholarship Program. If your family meets the qualifications, we encourage you to complete the application. We have had several Edgewood students complete the program successfully and graduate with the Take Stock in Children Scholarship. The Take Stock in Children program provides valuable resources for the students who are selected.

This year the Take Stock in Children application process will be completely different. Due to Covid-19, the TSIC application will be online for students to complete. We are using Award Spring. This is the same platform Seniors used last year to complete BSF scholarships. Students may apply to the Take Stock in Children program in grades: **7th, 8th, & 9th**. The application window to participate in the Take Stock in

Children mentoring program **opens on October 1, 2020 and closes November 30, 2020**. We need your help and the assistance of BPS teachers to identify possible candidates for Take Stock in Children.

1. The ideal candidate - We are seeking qualified students that meet the economic criteria (Free. Reduced Lunch), with the desire, aptitude, and capacity to matriculate to college, but simply need help getting there (navigating the process). Students must be willing to put in the hard work.
2. We are a multi-year, mentoring program first and foremost. Students must desire to partner with a mentor and be willing to participate in a weekly school-based mentoring program.
3. After successfully graduating high school and completing the TSIC program requirements, students will receive a 60 credit - Florida Prepaid tuition scholarship for college.

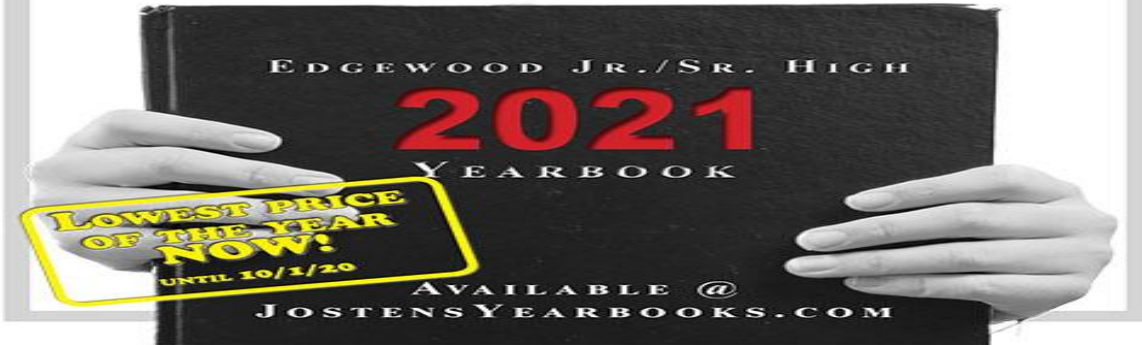
