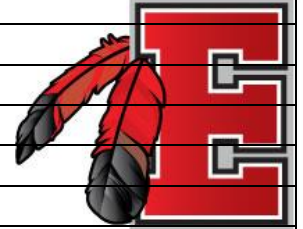

September SAC Public Comment Statement

At the September 17th School Advisory Council (SAC) meeting, the first of two listening sessions will be conducted for the SAC members to hear feedback from the community regarding the mascot review. The meeting will be hosted virtually through a Microsoft Live Event that can be followed through the link below. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, there will be two avenues offered to express thoughts and opinions about the Edgewood mascot. The two options include presenting in-person at a remote livestream location on campus or submitting a statement in writing through the Google form below. If you wish to give the SAC committee your thoughts, please complete the Google form. September's SAC meeting will have time allotted for 40 speakers at the remote livestream location. Speakers will have two minutes to share their thoughts with the SAC committee. SAC members will have the opportunity to hear all speakers as well as read the comments in all written statements. You must complete the form and submit it by midnight on September 13th. This is a hard deadline.

If you choose the remote livestream location option on the Google form and you are among the first 40 people submitting a request to speak, you will be notified via e-mail the week of September 14th.

If you are not among the first 40 for the September meeting, you will have a second opportunity to sign up to speak at the following SAC meeting on October 15th. It is expected that all presenters maintain professionalism and follow the appropriate decorum of a public venue. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of your time.

All written statements submitted through the Google form should be professional in nature. All offensive and/or vulgar submissions will be discarded and will not be taken into consideration.

Impact Aid Survey Information

Federal installations such as NASA and Patrick AFB occupy thousands of acres of Brevard County land. Such property is removed from the tax rolls of the county, resulting in the loss of a substantial source of revenue through ad valorem taxes. To compensate partially for this loss of revenue, legislation providing aid to impacted areas was enacted by Congress. To qualify for these funds, it is necessary that employment-survey questionnaires be completed by parents of students in September each year. The information requested is brief and does not violate any security regulations.

These forms will be distributed to students during the week of September 14-18, 2020. Forms must be returned to the school by Monday, September 21, 2020. Parent cooperation is appreciated in the completion and return of the questionnaire. Contact Dr. Diakakis for questions.

Mental Health Curriculum

Edgewood will continue to provide 30 minutes of mental health curriculum on early release Fridays during the 3rd period. The curriculum will specifically target the social and emotional learning of students. Social and Emotional Learning is defined as "the process through which children and adults understand and manage emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions." Specifically, this curriculum will target five core competencies: Self-Awareness, Self-Management, Social Awareness, Relationship Skills, and Responsible Decision Making.

Each Friday for 30 minutes, students, with their 3rd-period teacher, will work through a lesson designed to target one of those five competencies. Students will be given time for reflection. We are asking that each student bring a journal of some sort (a composition book, spiral notebook, etc.) in which students will be able to reflect on the lessons. These journals will be a confidential and a place for students to express their thoughts and feelings on the lesson taught. E-learners can also participate with a journal of their own to be kept at home.

7th – 10th Grade

Progress Monitoring

In accordance with Executive Order No. 20-52, school districts must expand their progress monitoring plans to include most of the 7th-10th grade students. This means that most Edgewood students in grades 7-10 will be taking a Reading Plus Benchmark (ELA) and a MAP Growth (math) computer-based assessment three times during the school year. The first testing window runs from August 26th – September 24th. Students will begin testing this week. If you are an E-Learning student your teacher will give you directions to take the Reading Plus assessment at home, however, the MAP will have to be taken at school. You will receive further information about the dates and times that you will be asked to come to campus later.

Testing Information

Monday 9/14 is the last day to purchase PSAT tickets. Students in grades 7-9 should bring \$17 cash/check to Mrs. Poley in the cafeteria between 8:00-8:30 or on the senior patio during all lunches. Students in grades 10-11 will be scheduled to test and are not required to submit payment. E-Learning students who wish to take the PSAT should bring their payment to the office during office hours in an envelope with their first and last name, grade and PSAT clearly marked. Emails will be sent out approximately two weeks before the October 14th testing date with the specific location and time that your child will test. Math Progress Monitoring (MAP) Assessments will be held the next two weeks for students in 7th grade, Algebra 1, and Geometry. E-Learners please check your email for more detailed instruction.
