Bright Futures:

- Need to be a Florida resident and a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- There are FOUR scholarships available, and each have their own criteria.
- Students may receive up to 5 years from HS graduation for a maximum of 120 semester hours toward completion of the first Bachelor's degree.
- Students must apply for the scholarship by submitting the Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA) **NO LATER THAN August 31 AFTER HS graduation.**
- **Volunteer Hours are due May 1st to assigned school counselor**

FAFSA:

- ANY student regardless of income can apply!
- It takes about an hour to complete.
- You and your parent will need to apply for your FSA ID first. (This takes a few days to receive)
- You will need your parent's SSN, DOB, email address and income information
- **Federal Deadline for 2024-2025 is June 30, 2025!**

Grad Bash - April 12th



- Meeting Location
 - Auditorium no later than 1:00
 - Once you enter the Auditorium, you will not be permitted to leave the Auditorium
- Buses
 - Bus assignments – order of payment – see Ms. Brown if you need more information
 - Depart from THS at 1:30
 - No eating or drinking on buses
 - NOTHING may be left on buses while in the park
 - Best behavior
 - Passes and/or wristbands will be handed out on the bus. If you receive a pass, take a picture of front and back

Dress Code

- ★ NO Midriff shirts
- ★ Shirts must be 3" wide (NO halter tops)
- ★ T-shirts and button downs allowed
 - NO UNDERSHIRTS
 - Jackets are allowed BUT NO school jackets
- ★ Jeans, leggings, running shorts, shorts, and skirts
- ★ No excessive holes/shreds on jeans
 - Legging CANNOT be sheer or see through material
 - Shorts/ running shorts shall be NO shorter than MID-THIGH
- ★ NO SPANDEX BODYSUITS
- ★ Comfortable shoes, tennis shoes, dress sandals, boots, and flip flops
- ★ Sunglasses, hats, belts, jewelry, and headbands
- ★ ALL bag/purses MUST be under the size of 8.5"x5.5" (half a sheet of paper)
- ★ Drawstring nylon bags are allowed as long as they fall within the 14"x 18" size requirement
- ★ Fanny packs are encouraged



What is NOT OK for Grad Bash

- ★ No school name or logos on attire
- ★ No clothing that exposes excessive portions of skin that may be considered inappropriate (bikinis, crop tops, extreme low cut tops, sagging pants, etc.)
- ★ No area codes on clothing
- ★ No excessive holes/ shredding, too tight or revealing clothing
- ★ No visible undergarments (bras, sports bras, underwear)
- ★ Tank Tops, undershirts, sleeveless tops (must be 3" in the straps)
- ★ Shorts/dresses/ rompers/skirts MUST be NO shorter than mid thigh
- ★ No nylon basketball shorts
- ★ NO ACCESSORIES SUCH AS CHAINS, SPIKES COLLARS, STUDDED/SPIKED BELTS, SHARP OBJECTS
- ★ No high school team name, logo, mascot
- ★ No jerseys of any kind (including college and professional)
- ★ NO SPANDEX BODY SUITS
