

A message from BREVARD COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Florida Department of Health have clarified the below travel advisory, which could impact plans for Brevard Public Schools families. As of Monday March 9:

- Students, families, and staff who return from countries that are under a Level 3 travel advisory -- China, Iran, Italy, and South Korea -- are asked to self-isolate for 14 days upon return. They should take their temperature twice a day, and report temperatures over 100.4 to their physician or to Florida Department of Health in Brevard County at 321-454-7101.

- Students, families, and staff who return from CRUISES or countries under a Level 2 travel advisory – Japan -- are directed to monitor their health and limit interactions with others for 14 days after returning to the United States. If they become symptomatic, they should immediately self-isolate and contact the Florida Department of Health in Brevard County at 321-454-7101 or their health provider.

- As of today, this guidance does not apply to ALL international travel, as was reported by some news media earlier Monday.
