PURPOSE OF THIS REPORT

The Florida Statewide Assessment Program is meant to help Florida students succeed, and the ELA, mathematics, science, and social studies assessments serve Florida students by measuring education gains and progress. Assessment supports instruction and student learning, and test results help Florida's educational leadership and stakeholders determine whether the goals of the education system are being met.

This report reflects your student's performance on the Spring 2023 U.S. History EOC assessment. It also allows you to compare your student's score to the performance of other students across the state. In addition, by looking at the points earned in each reporting category, you can identify skill areas that may need improvement.



In this category, students are expected to understand and articulate the impact of issues related to the Civil War, Reconstruction, the closing of the frontier, the industrialization of the nation, and changes in American society at the beginning of the twentieth century. Global Military, Political, and Economic Challenges (1890-1940)		
In this category, students are expected to understand and articulate the impact of the issues related to the rise of American military power; America's increased involvement in world affairs; and changing social, political, and economic forces affecting the 1920s and 1930s. The United States and the Defense of the International Peace (1940-2010)		
In this category, students are expected to understand and articulate the impact of issues related to World War II, the Cold War, the social revolutions of the late twentieth century, and the challenges of the early twenty-first century. En esta categoría, se espera que los estudiantes comprendan y expresen el impacto de los asuntos relacionados con la Segunda Guerra Mundial, la Guerra Fría, las revoluciones sociales de finales del siglo XX y los retos de comienzos del siglo XXI.
