



# FTE Overview

- Full Time Equivalent (FTE) is the basis for district funding through the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP)
- One unit of FTE represents one K-12 student attending public school with a full-time schedule for the 180-day school year
  - PK students receiving ESE services are funded through the FEFP
- FTE is primarily earned in Surveys 2 (Oct) and 3 (Feb)
  - DJJ Programs earn FTE in Surveys 1 and 4 (summer)
  - Additional FTE is earned in Survey 5 for Early Graduates, Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB) and Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Programs
- To be reported for Survey, a student must be ENROLLED during the 5-day period ending with Date Certain. To be reported with FTE a student must have been in ATTENDANCE at least once during the 11-day period ending with Date Certain.
