



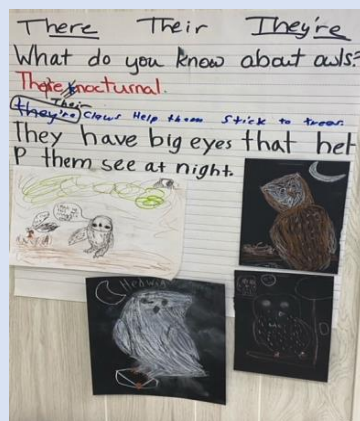

Our Pasta for Pennies raised \$2,484.69.

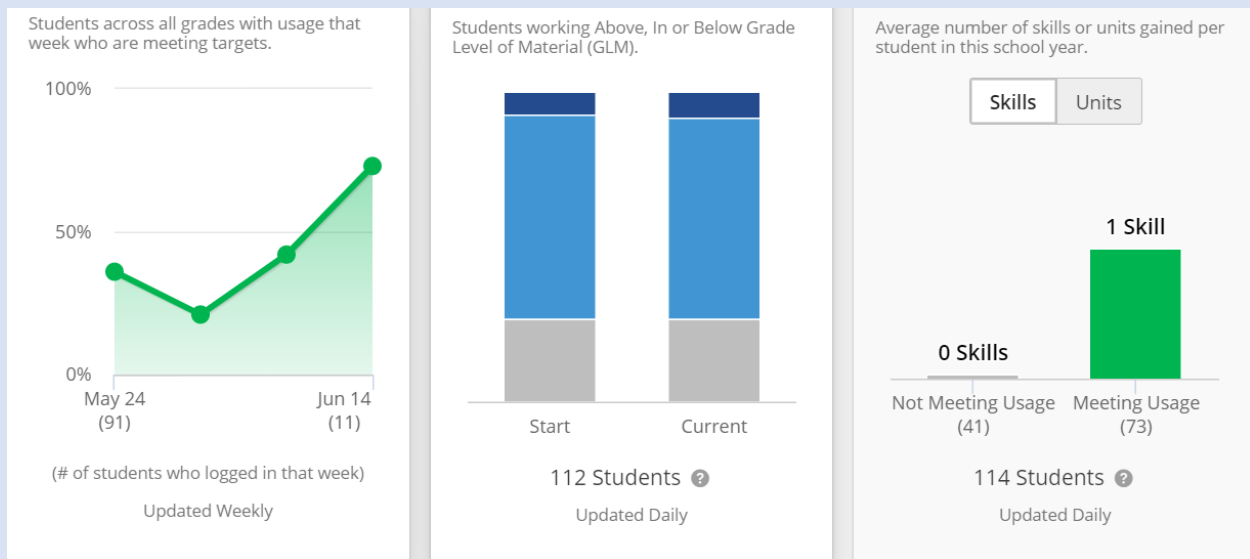
1st place class raising \$468.47 ---> Wailes

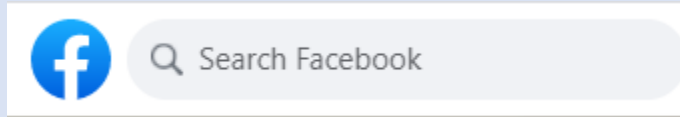
