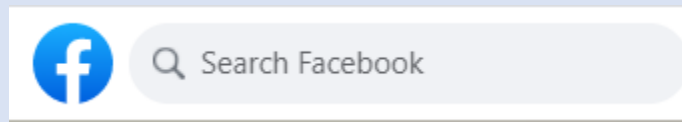

### Education Location Option

The Open Enrollment window opens **April 30<sup>th</sup> to June 4<sup>th</sup>** for new and returning ELO student applications. This enables the selection of a school outside of the family's residential zoned school of attendance.
