## Introduction

Brevard Public Schools offer several options for acceleration and post-secondary credit: the Advanced Placement (AP) Program, Dual Enrollment, the International Baccalaureate (IB) Program, and the Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Program. Most colleges and universities in the United States as well as many postsecondary schools throughout the world recognize AP, AICE, and IB exam results and award college credit or placement into higher-level college courses based upon students' success in these curricula. All Florida state colleges and universities award credit by examination equivalencies. The 2017 district test results for AP, IB and AICE are included in this report.

Advanced Placement (AP) is a series of college-level courses and examinations offered by the Advanced Placement Program and administered by the College Board. Course descriptions and course examinations are prepared by the College Board, and the examinations are administered at high school sites in May of each year. Students who successfully complete the course work in an AP course receive high school credit. Postsecondary credit for an AP course may be awarded to a student who scores a minimum of 3 on a 5 -point scale on the corresponding AP exam. More than 2.3 million students have taken AP examinations in 19,000 schools world-wide. Most four-year colleges in the United States and colleges in more than 60 other countries give students credit, advanced academic status, or both on the basis of AP exam scores. Fifteen of the district's sixteen high schools offer the Advanced Placement (AP) Program. The scores in this report reflect only those students who were enrolled in Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate and Advanced International Certificate of Education courses in Brevard Public Schools. Starting in school year 2014-15, several Brevard County Schools offered the Advanced Placement Capstone Diploma.

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Program is an internationally recognized accelerated program in which students may earn college and university credits. The IB program is based in Geneva, Switzerland, serving students in 4,267 schools in 146 counties around the world. During the past year, IB students at both Cocoa Beach High School and Melbourne High School earned college credit through diplomas and through success on examinations.

The Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Program is part of the University of Cambridge in Cambridge, England and operates in more than 12,000 schools in over 140 countries around the world. Students who are successful on their Cambridge examinations and students who earn AICE diplomas may earn post-secondary credit while still in high school. During the past year, AICE students at Eau Gallie High School, Heritage High School, and Rockledge High School earned credit through diplomas and through success on examinations.

## Advanced Placement Results

There are 34 different AP courses that were offered in Brevard's high schools in 2016-17. The number of students taking these courses has increased from 3,770 in 2013 to 4,418 in 2017. The number of tests taken has also increased from 6,645 in 2013 to 7,938 in 2017. Minority participation has increased in the past five years from 1,001 candidates taking 1,614 tests in 2013 to 1,458 candidates taking 2,519 tests in 2017. As part of Brevard Public Schools' College and Career Readiness focus, AP is included as one of the rigorous course requirement options.

The AP students in Brevard Public Schools have achieved outstanding results in their coursework and exams during the 2016-17 academic year. The overall results of the Advanced Placement exams show that the percentage of Brevard students scoring 3 or higher is greater than the Florida state percentage. Brevard students outscored or equaled students in Florida and the world in 18 out of 34 subject area tests. The percentage of total tests scoring 3 or higher in Brevard was 57.3\%. That is higher than the state percentage of $54.6 \%$.

Students and their families benefit from enrollment and success in Advanced Placement courses in many important ways. They may earn credit, advanced standing, or both for college. They may earn scholarships, save money on college tuition, and even graduate early from college. Their success in Advanced Placement programs gives the students access to public and private universities as well as community colleges. AP courses are rigorous, challenging, and in-depth. The Advanced Placement program strengthens the link between high school and post high school education and encourages student achievement.

## Executive Summary 2017

The Brevard Public Schools Accelerated Programs Report 2017 indicates positive performance in both the number of AP tests administered and in the percent of scores of 3 or above. The overall results are positive; however, specific areas of concern do exist. This executive summary succinctly illustrates the many strengths of the district, the areas of concern that must be addressed, and recommendations for further improvement.

## Strengths

- The number of students participating in AP courses has increased from 3,770 in 2013 to 4,418 in 2017, an increase of 17.2\%. Participation in AP has also increased as a percentage of total 9-12 student population from $15.9 \%$ in 2013 to $19.8 \%$ in 2017.
- A strong policy of open enrollment coupled with appropriate advising and counseling have maintained an appropriate balance between equity and access.
- The number of AP exams has increased from 6,645 in 2013 to 7,938 in 2017, an increase of 19.4\%.
- The number of AP exams that earned scores of 3 or higher has increased from 4,175 in 2013 to 4,556 in 2017, an increase of $9.2 \%$.
- The percentage of total tests scoring 3 or higher in Brevard was 57.3\%. That is higher than the state percentage of 54.6\%
- Even though Brevard students are required to participate in the assessment program if enrolled in the AP course, exam results for specific courses compare extremely well with the state and global percentage of students scoring 3 or higher.


## Areas of Concern

- Some courses have a high percentage of students scoring a 1 on the exam districtwide: Human Geography-38.2\%, Physics-1 34\% and Computer Science A-53.5\%.
- Teacher training for specific courses needs to be evaluated as indicated by courses with 10 or more students when the percentage of students scoring 3 or higher is less than the district and/or state percentage.
- Minority participation and performance continues to be a concern. The number of exams taken by Black students has increased slightly from 307 exams in 2013 to 309 exams in 2017. Their performance is lower than any other minority group and the percentage of exams earning 3 or higher by Black students decreased from $39.4 \%$ in 2013 to $27.9 \%$ in 2017.


## Recommendations

The Brevard County Public School district strives to provide the best possible accelerated program through the Advanced Placement Program. Appropriate training for Advanced Placement teachers is offered through professional institutes, workshops, discussion groups, and teacher visits to successful programs. The following are recommendations for further improvement:

- Provide appropriate advisement and counseling concerning enrollment in an AP course to ensure the program's success. However, the final decision on AP course enrollment belongs to the parent and student.
- Focus on the identification of minority students with a focus on Black students in order to decrease the equity gap that now exists.
- Prepare minority students for more rigorous coursework throughout their academic careers.
- Review and revise, when appropriate, the existing AP curriculum to align with the current College Board AP course descriptions, suggested syllabi, and testing criteria.
- Review teacher selection for courses where student performance is extremely low compared to the district.
- Encourage articulation among middle schools and high schools in developing Vertical Teams, and AVID strategies to begin preparation for AP at the middle school and early high school levels.
- Provide teacher in-service training in specific courses where percentage scoring 3 or higher is below district-wide performance.
- Establish discussion groups or planning teams for teachers in the district teaching the same AP course.
- Utilize the AP Instructional Planning Report and AP Policies and Procedures Handbook to identify strengths and weaknesses in the AP classroom instruction.
- Make use of valuable College Board resources provided on www.collegeboard.com. AP Central provides course descriptions for all subject areas, teacher's guides, sample syllabi, and released exams.
- Solicit teachers to become involved in the AP examination reading process to gain insight regarding the exam grading process.
- Train counselors and teachers to utilize assessment data and AP potential to recommend individual AP course selection(s) based upon data from the PSAT as available.
- Hold parent and student informational meetings about the benefits of Advanced Placement coursework for BPS students.
- Use Khan Academy resources for AP courses.
- Suggest school improvement plans address the following:
a. areas of achievement below state averages
b. increased enrollment of underrepresented populations
c. increased overall enrollment in AP courses
d. utilization of teacher training and other strategies to improve results in specific courses

## Access/Participation in AP Program

## Brevard Public Schools

Increased access/participation in the AP program continues to be a district priority in Brevard Public Schools. The district's College and Career Readiness initiative focuses on rigorous course requirements. In addition, participation in AP courses is important for college admission in the Florida State University System. Data also indicates that students who take two or more Advanced Placement classes are more likely to graduate from college in four years or less (U. S. Department of Education).

Participation increased between 2015-16 and 2016-17.

## District Test Results 2017

There were 4,418 students who took 7,938 Advanced Placement tests in Brevard in May of 2017, representing $20.4 \%$ of total $9-12$ student enrollment. Scores of 3 or better were reported on 4,556 tests, representing $57.3 \%$ of the tests taken, resulting in approximately 729 additional FTE units for the district. Funds are used primarily to provide additional teaching units, AP tests, and teacher bonuses. When available, funding is provided for supplies and materials for AP teachers.

## District Test Results by Ethnicity as Reported by College Board 2017

Of the 4,418 AP candidates, 1,385 or $31.3 \%$ identified themselves as minority students. The distribution of ethnic groups participating in AP courses is shown below. Asian students account for $5.7 \%$, Blacks students $4.9 \%$, Hispanic students $14.6 \%$, and Multi-Racial is $5.6 \%$. Compared to the ethnic distribution of all Brevard high school students (Asian 2.7\%, Black $14.3 \%$, and Hispanic 11\%), the AP program has a much higher representation of Asian students, a higher representation of Hispanic students and a dramatically lower representation of Black students.

## District Test Results for 5 Largest Ethnicity Groups as reported by College Board 2013-2017

The participation of all minority students has increased over the last five years. Exams taken by Black students increased slightly from 307 to 309 from 2013 to 2017; however, their tests which earned a score of 3 or better decreased from $39.4 \%$ to $27.9 \%$. This number remains low in comparison to other ethnic groups. Hispanic students have almost doubled their participation since 2013, but their performance has dropped from $57.8 \%$ of tests scoring 3 or above to $54.9 \%$. White students have increased in participation and continue to be the largest group while their performance has decreased from $64.6 \%$ of tests scoring 3 or above in 2013 to $59.1 \%$ in 2017. The category Multi-Racial has only been available for students to choose since 2015 and therefore can only be compared since 2015. That group has grown steadily both in participation and exams receiving 3 and above.

## International Baccalaureate (IB) Test Results 2013-2017

The IB Program in Brevard Public Schools has decreased over the last five years. In 2013 638 tests were taken compared to 545 in 2017 for a decrease of $14.6 \%$. The number of tests earning 4 or above has decreased from 587 in 2013 to 468 in 2017 for a decrease of $20.2 \%$. There was a substantial increase in participation and success when compared to 2016. Participation increased by $14.5 \%$ and exams with a 4 or above increased by 18.5\%.

During the past year, students at Eau Gallie High School, Heritage High School and Rockledge High School earned credit through diplomas and through success on examinations.

To earn college credit on AICE exams, students must earn scores of E or better. The percentage of students achieving scores of $E$ or better in the district was $69.8 \%$. The total number of candidates for AICE diplomas was 256 with 184 (71.9\%) earning diplomas. The total number of exams taken was 2,433 .
