## Program Description:

**The course is completely online.** Students can log into the course remotely after receipt of registration and course enrollment information.

## Program Structure:

The OSHA 10-Hour General Industry training course consists of interactive modules which includes the following:

## Program Requirements:

Students will need to enroll in the course at a Brevard Adult Education Office and have access to a computer which meets program requirements. Diploma/GED is not required for enrollment.

## Completion Requirements:

- Students must pass all module assessments within 3 attempts with a grade of 70% or higher and complete the course survey.
- Students must complete the course within 6 months from enrollment.
- Students must spend a minimum of 2 days taking the course with not more than 7.5 hours in a single day.
