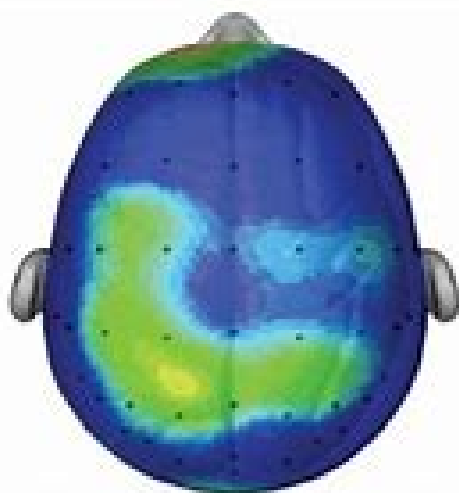
This year we will run Mileage Club every Wednesday and Thursday morning at 8:10am starting on Wednesday, September 12th, 2018

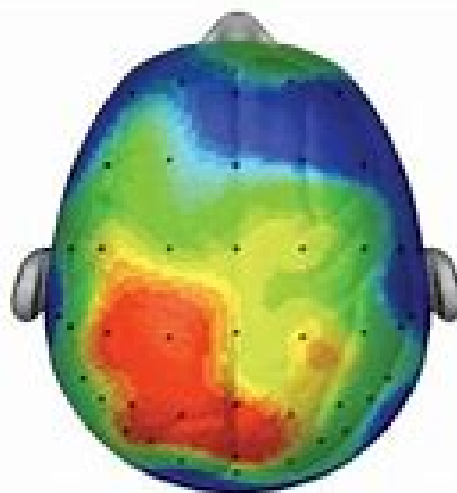
