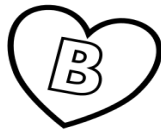

Sabal Elementary earned school grade of a B for the 2016-2017 school year. We are so PROUD of our students, staff and parents that worked together as a team. Additionally, our APTT program helped parents to work with their child at home on targeted skills that supported the learning in the classroom. 60% of students scored on grade level in English Language Arts Achievement (ELA), 64% of students made learning gains in ELA. 51% of students scored on grade level in math. 55% of students scored on grade level in Science.

FSA Scores are Available

Sabal has received scores from the Department of Education for the 2017 Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) taken during April and May. The reports explain the student's achievement in detail for English Language Arts(ELA) and Math. There are no achievement levels attached to these scores as was reported in the past FCAT scores. However, the FSA scores reflect a percentile ranking of how students compare with other students who took the same assessments within the state of Florida. If you need help understanding the report or need it translated into another language please call the front office. FSA scores that were not picked up on registration day or open house, were sent home on Thursday, August 31st.
