School Improvement Plan (SIP) Goals 2019-2020

- 1. We will increase the reading proficiency of SWD by at least 5% increasing from 15% to 20% proficiency.**
- 2. During the 19-20 school year, the math learning gains for our lowest 25% will increase from 48% to 53%, our proficiency will increase from 58% to 63% and our learning gains will have a 5% increase.**
- 3. ELA proficiency will increase from 51% to 56%. ELA learning gains will increase from 61% to 66% and ELA lowest 25% will increase from 68% to 73%.**

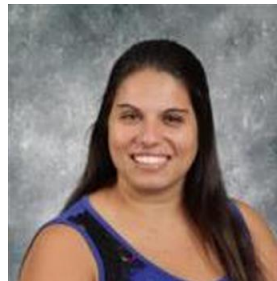
- 3 Title 1 Teachers- these teachers support students in K-6 using by assisting with intervention and small group instruction

- **What is it?** Week long program at Brevard Zoo that focuses on 3rd and 4th grade standards that will be assessed on the Science State Assessment. (Week of April 22)
- **Who Uses It?** 5th Grade Students
- **Cost?** \$2000.00
- **Was the strategy effective?** This event was cancelled due to COVID-19 school closures; Money will be refunded to school

i-Ready Online Reading Instruction/ i-Ready Toolbox

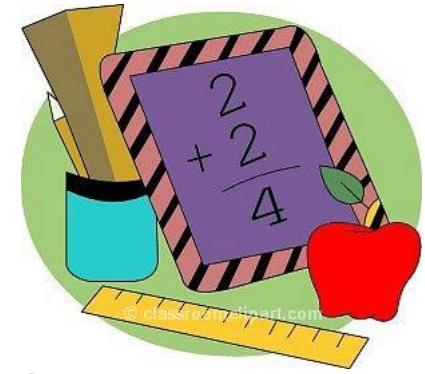
Supplemental Resources

- **What is it?** i-Ready is an interactive online learning program designed to assess students and provide individualized instruction
- **Who Uses It?** K-6th grade
- **Cost?** Online Learning \$7,000; Toolbox \$4,000
- **Was the strategy effective?** Students in Tier 1 increased from 28% (Diagnostic 1) to 44% (Diagnostic 2) in grades 1st-6th and increased from 25% to 65% in K



Supplemental Resources

Big Ideas



- **What is it?** Online Math Curriculum
- **Who Uses It?** 6th Grade Students/Teachers
- **Cost?** \$1,050
- **Was the strategy effective?** Looking at the Math i-Ready Diagnostic, 6th grade students in Tier 1 increased from 37% (Diagnostic 1) to 48% (Diagnostic 2)

Flocabulary

Supplemental Resources

- **What is it?** An online resource that has songs with videos that students can listen to that are aligned to standards as well as quizzes they can take after listening to the songs
- **Who Uses It?** All grade levels have access to this program
- **Cost?** \$2,500.00
- **Was the strategy effective?** Based on a survey given to teachers, 9 teachers utilize this program and of those 9, 90% use it at least weekly to help engage students and provide them with another way for students to understand





Supplemental Resources

Coach Digital

- **What is it?** An online digital resource of Standards Based Reading supplemental materials
- **Who Uses It?** Students/Teachers in grades 1st-6th
- **Cost?** \$2,499.00
- **Was the strategy effective?** Using i-Ready ELA data, Students in Tier 1 increased from 28% (Diagnostic 1) to 44% (Diagnostic 2) in grades 1st-6th and increased from 25% to 65% in K.



Supplemental Resources

Accelerated Reader

- **What is it?** is a computer-based program that schools may use to monitor *reading* practice and progress. It helps teachers guide kids to books that are on kids' individual *reading* levels. Students take short quizzes after *reading* a book to check if they've understood it.
- **Who Uses It?** Students in grades 2nd-6th
- **Cost?** \$5,371.50
- **Was the strategy effective?** Number of words read in September was 1,479,650 and has increased in February, to 5,982,201 words read.

Supplemental Resources

Rolling Readers



- **What is it?** A children literacy program that is facilitated by volunteers, who read aloud in classrooms on a weekly basis.
- **Who Uses It?** K and VPK
- **Cost?** \$228
- **Was the strategy effective?** Teachers surveyed felt that it was beneficial to students' foundational reading skills.

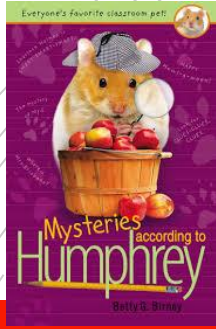

Parent and Family Engagement



- Whole School Book Study: “Mysteries According to Humphrey”
- Every student received a book along with questions and a pacing guide created by our Literacy Coach. Teachers supported this event by promoting and reading along with their students.
- Cost: \$550
- Was it effective? Parents were surveyed and 50% would like another book study, and 50% are not sure if they would or not (4 responses). Due to low survey results online, another survey will be sent home paper/paper in August.
