LEVEL A PLUS VOLUNTEER

WHAT IS A LEVEL A – PLUS - VOLUNTEER?

Direct Unsupervised contact with student is permitted

Applies to: All non-contractual tutors, non-contractual mentors, chaperones for out-of-county field or athletic trips, chaperones for overnight field or athletic trips, field trip drivers, and athletic team drivers

- Volunteers are fully fingerprinted – \$47.00 fee applies
- Volunteers subject to a Level II FBI criminal background check
- Volunteers subject to a sexual offender/sexual predator check

AS A LEVEL A - PLUS VOLUNTEER, IN WHAT CAPACITY CAN I VOLUNTEER?

- CAN work in a non-classroom environment such as the main office or library
- CAN work in a large school related event (*Examples: Volunteering at Fall or Spring festivals or sporting event concessions*)
- CAN work from home on a school related volunteer activity (*Example: Counting box tops for the school*)
- CAN have one on one contact with a student (*Examples: Volunteer Mentors, Volunteer Coaches, Volunteer Tutors*)
- CAN chaperone in-county AND out of county field trips and be individually responsible for groups of children
- CAN chaperone overnight field trips
- CAN transport a group of students in a private vehicle

WHAT IS THE PROCESS TO BECOME A LEVEL A PLUS VOLUNTEER?

- Complete online application process at:

- Finalize the application process by coming to the Office of District and School Security
- Complete fingerprinting at the Office of District Security
 - Remember to bring a valid state issued identification with you for fingerprinting
 - Valid forms of payment are credit card or money order (*Cash cannot be accepted; A debit cards with a Visa/Mastercard logo can be processed*)

HOW LONG IS THE LEVEL A PLUS STATUS VALID FOR?

- Level A PLUS status is valid for 5 years
