LEVEL A VOLUNTEER

WHAT IS A LEVEL A VOLUNTEER?

Direct Unsupervised one-on-one contact with student is **NOT** permitted; While in contact with Students, all Level A volunteers **MUST** be within line of sight of a District Employee

Applies to: In-county field trip chaperones, in-county athletic team chaperones, volunteers supervising small groups of students

- Online Registration - \$20 fee for Level A volunteers
- Volunteers receive an available open source criminal background check
- Volunteers receive a sexual offender/sexual predator check

AS A LEVEL A VOLUNTEER, IN WHAT CAPACITY CAN I VOLUNTEER?

- CAN work in a non-classroom environment such as the main office or library
- CAN work in a large school related event (*Examples: Volunteering at Fall or Spring festivals or sporting event concessions*)
- CAN work from home on a school related volunteer activity (*Example: Counting box tops for the school*)
- CAN interact directly with students while within “line of sight” of a BPS employee
- CAN chaperone in-county field trips and be responsible for groups of students
- CAN transport a group of students in a private vehicle

WHAT IS THE PROCESS TO BECOME A LEVEL A VOLUNTEER?

HOW LONG IS THE LEVEL A STATUS VALID FOR?

- Level B status is valid for 3 years
