

# Rockledge High School Homecoming/Prom Dance

## Dress Code

Students and guests who are not in compliance with the dress code will not be allowed to enter the dance. If a student is found to be in violation of Dress Code during the dance, a parent will be called and asked to pick up their student at that time. Refunds will not be provided to a student or date for non-compliance. The Homecoming Dress Code complies with the school dress code with a few exceptions due to the semi-formal/formal nature of this dance. Take care of any questions prior to attending the dance by seeing an administrator.

## Females-Acceptable Clothing/Accessories

Dressy pants, long or short dresses.

Spaghetti straps or strapless dresses are acceptable if designed as a semi-formal or formal dress. Open back dresses are acceptable as long as the front is covered.

Dress Shoes (flats or heels)

## Females-Unacceptable Clothing/Accessories

See-Through dresses

A dress or 2 piece combination that bares the midriff, front midriffs must be completely covered at all times.

Backless dresses below waistline.

## Males-Acceptable Clothing/Accessories

Dress pants.

Dress shirt with tie or banded collar

Suit/Sport Coats with tie are appropriate

Dress Shoes

Tuxedo

## Male-Unacceptable Clothing/Accessories

Canes

Wife beater undershirts

T-shirts or non-dress shirts

Tank Tops

Work boots

## All students-Unacceptable Clothing/Accessories

Denim of any type and color is unacceptable for the dance by either gender.

Wearing head garments of any kind is unacceptable.

Combat boots or the like are not allowed.

Glow sticks, pacifiers, or ring candy will not be permitted. Removal from the dance without a refund will result if a student or guest is using one of these items, with possible assistance from the officers on duty.

Masks of any kind.

## Non-RHS Guest

RHS students may bring one non-RHS student upon approval by administration. Students must complete the guest forms completely and have them approved by an administrator no less than ONE WEEK prior to the event **Late forms will NOT be accepted for any reason. Non-RHS guests must be under the age of 21 at the time of the dance and may not be in 8th grade or lower.** Dances are a "High School" event and therefore they are for "High School" students The administration will NOT grant permission to Non-RHS students who: 1.) have had discipline problems during their high school careers; 2.) do not have a GPA required for activities; 3.) have poor attendance records in school; 4.) have ever been expelled or put in an Alternative Learning Center; or 5.) any student about whom the administration cannot find out sufficient information.

Information needed for the guest form includes:

- Guest's complete name.
- Parent's name.
- Parent Contact number (This is in case of an emergency.)
- School Currently Attending/grade level (if out of school, name of employer and manager).
- School phone number (if out of school, work number)

If you have any questions or may think your guest will not be approved for the dance, please contact an administrator prior to submitting the form.

### **Homecoming Ticket Purchasing Information**

**Tickets sales will begin September 12, 2018. Tickets will be sold in room 801 during lunches. Tickets will not be sold after October 5, 2018 for any reason.**

Approved forms for Non-RHS dates will be located with the ticket sellers. If your non-RHS guest was not approved, you may not purchase a ticket for him or her. Non-RHS guest must be under the age of 21 and may not be in 8th grade or lower.

**Tickets will be \$30 per person (CASH ONLY).** If purchasing a ticket for a RHS student (date), you will need to either purchase the tickets together or have a copy of the student's (date's) student ID with you. All students (RHS and non-RHS) will need a photo ID to enter the dance, no exceptions will be made. All obligations must be met prior to purchasing tickets. The form must be completely filled out (**ALL BLANKS**) before non-RHS student will even be considered.

### **Transportation to and from the Homecoming Dance**

Students will not be permitted transportation to the event by a charter/commercial bus. The Administration has concerns for safety, supervision, security, and the risks involved with the late night/centralized locations that are used by commercial carriers for drop-off/return of students. Therefore, students will not be allowed to come to the any event via this means of transportation. Students who violate this policy and arrive to the dance via a commercial/charter bus will not be granted admission to the dance and will be directed to leave the dance location. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR TICKETS!** Students may still utilize standard commercial vehicles such as limos, stretch hummers, etc. or their own personal means of transportation. Thank you for your understanding.

### **Acceptable/Unacceptable Dancing**

Any suggestive, obscene, provocative, risqué or sexy dancing will not be tolerated at the dance. Students will be removed from the dance, if they are involved in any unacceptable dancing.

There will be **NO** Grinding Front to Front-Back to Back- or In Groups.

There will be **NO** dancing of an overtly sexual nature.

Students' hands are to be kept in appropriate **places**.

**There will be NO Slam Dancing or Mashing**
