Adoption of agenda. Motion to approve by Holli Zander, 2nd by Melissa Thomke, passing unanimously.

School updates were provided by principal Holli Zander: Enrollment is at 2044 students. Jurassic Park replacement total was \$287.68 plus shipping. Motion to approve was made by Vanessa Jara. 2nd by Melissa Thomke and unanimously passed. Wuthering Heights replacement total was \$223.68 plus shipping. Motion to approve was made by Cheryl Chamberlain, 2nd by Jacalyn Anderson and also passed unanimously.
