

School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes

Date: Monday, March 11, 2019

Location: BHS Media Center

1. The meeting was called to order at 16:00.
2. Minutes from February 11th meeting were reviewed. The minutes were approved at 16:01.
3. Ms. Wiebelt introduced a proposal to spend portion of SAC funds on teacher training. Three teachers expressed interest in attending Advanced Placement conference in Orlando during the summer and are requesting funding to cover registration cost of \$350.00 per teacher for a total of \$1050.00. Proposal will be e-mailed to the SAC committee members who will vote during next meeting (April 15th).
Ms. Wiebelt explained that SAC has about \$7000.00 at its disposal and it also has voting rights over leftover money from School Recognition Funds from 2015 and 2018 school years which are about \$6000.00 in total. Ms. Wiebelt may ask SAC committee to approve some of these funds for security updates after the district has completed their upcoming safety evaluation of the school.
4. A concern over reckless driving by our students on Bayside Lakes Boulevard after the dismissal was brought up. School Resource Officer (SRO), Daniel Ellis, explained that there are about four Palm Bay police officers on duty who cover our and Heritage High School zones in the afternoon, so it is difficult to receive their assistance with this matter even though multiple requests were made by our SRO.
