

School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes

Date: Monday, April 15, 2019

Location: BHS Media Center

1. The meeting was called to order at 16:00.
2. Minutes from March 11th meeting were reviewed. The minutes were approved at 16:02.
3. Ms. Kaleel introduced a proposal to spend a portion of SAC funds on teacher training. Three teachers expressed interest in attending the Advanced Placement conference in Orlando during the summer and are requesting funding to cover the registration cost of \$350.00 per teacher for a total of \$1050.00. Increasing enrollment in Advanced Placement courses is a focus for Bayside High School.
Motion for approval of funds was introduced by Mr. Winter, seconded by Mr. Ellis, and unanimously approved by SAC members at 16:06.
4. Mr. Rubick introduced a proposal to spend another portion of SAC funds on training two additional AP teachers. The training will take place in Tampa, Florida, during the month of July. The funding is needed to cover registration and accommodations for two teachers not to exceed \$1400.00 per teacher for a total of \$2800.00. Motion for approval of funds was introduced by Ms. Kaleel, seconded by Mr. Callinan, and unanimously approved by SAC members at 16:12.
5. Mr. Winter asked about additional school needs such as new technology in the form of laptop carts and safety updates. Ms. Wiebelt responded that Brevard School District is working on providing a solution for placing a film on doors and windows while Bayside staff is working on window covers. Bayside would welcome new laptop carts but teacher desktop computers are aging so technology integrator will evaluate and prioritize our needs after testing window.
6. Ms. Wiebelt introduced the forming of a discipline committee lead by our deans with a teacher representative from all departments as members. The intent of this committee is to provide more consistency in the implementation of district discipline policy and to share data with teachers to provide insight into the events and actions which happen behind the scenes.
7. Ms. Wiebelt commented on the continuation of work with engagement strategies with poverty in mind and introduction of professional development series with a focus on social-emotional needs of our students. The training will be developed by Ms. Finch and Mr. Guevara.
8. A question was introduced if seniors may decorate their caps for graduations. Ms. Wiebelt responded that decorations which do not interfere with other students are acceptable.
9. Next SAC meeting is on May 13th at Bayside High School Media Center.
