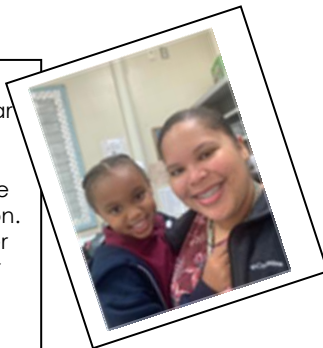

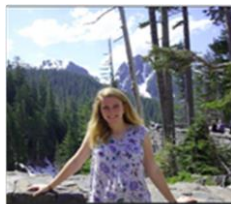
Our New Stevenson Teachers!
