


Is it Bullying?

- When someone says or does something <u>unintentionally</u> hurtful and they do it once, that's **RUDE**.
- When someone says or does something <u>intentionally</u> hurtful and they do it once, that's **MEAN**.
- When someone says or does something <u>intentionally</u> hurtful and they keep doing it even when you tell them to stop or show them that you're upset, that's **BULLYING**.

CONFLICT	RUDE	MEAN	BULLYING
Occasional	Occasional	Once or Twice	Is REPEATED
Not planned; in the heat of the moment	Spontaneous: unintentional	Intentional	Is planned and done on purpose
All parties are upset	Can cause hurt feelings; upset	Can hurt others deeply	The target of the bullying is upset
All parties want to work things out	Based in thoughtlessness, poor manners	Based in anger; impulsive cruelty	The bully is trying to gain control over the target
All parties will accept responsibility	Rude person accepts responsibility	Behavior often regretted;	The bully blames the target
An effort is made by all parties to solve the problem			The target wants to stop the bully's behavior, the bully does not
Can be resolved through mediation	Social skill building could be of benefit	Needs to be addressed/ should NOT be ignored	CANNOT be resolved through mediation
