
Welcome Back Croton Families!

Important Safety Information

Pick up and Drop off is not permitted in the front parking lot/loop. Use the car loop on

the side of the school for drop off and pick up.

When picking up your walkers, please do not park in Croton's parking lots or next door in the business parking lot.

The gates open for pick up in the car loop at 2:15 Monday through Thursday, and 1:00 on Fridays. Please do not pull ahead of other cars already lined up.

During dismissal from the carloop students will be called from youngest to oldest. The older siblings need to listen for their names and go to their younger sibling's gate for pickup.

Great news! Under the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) of the National School Lunch Program, Croton Elementary School will offer both **NO COST** breakfast and lunch to all enrolled students for the 2020-21 school year. No need to complete a Free & Reduced Application. Students can join us between

7:30 and 7:50 for a free breakfast in the cafeteria. Students still need to be in their classrooms no later than 8:00 a.m. Supervision does not begin until 7:30 a.m. for any student, so please be sure they do not arrive too early. Curbside breakfast and lunch pick-up is available for eLearning students at 9:30 a.m. Monday through Friday. Please pull in the back parking lot.

Your child may still purchase a la cart items, if they wish. Students are permitted no more than two snacks at lunch (one salty and one sweet). We are encouraging cashless payments this year. Payments may be pre-paid into your child's lunch account free of charge online at https://www.mypaymentsplus.com/.

Attendance Matters

It is very important that students arrive to campus on time each day. We are committed to ensuring academic excellence for all our students and that begins with daily attendance. We need your assistance to support regular attendance:



- Make sure your child/children keep a regular bedtime and establish a morning routine.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Ensure that your child/children attend school every day unless they are truly sick.
- Avoid scheduling doctor's appointments when school is in session.
- Please ensure that eLearners are following the school day schedule as they would if they were on campus.
- Develop a back-up plan for getting your child/children to school if something comes up. For example, call on a family member, neighbor or another parent to take your child to school.
- Students may only be signed out by a custodial parent or notification must be received in writing from a custodial parent to release to someone else on the approved check out list.
- We value, appreciate, and seek out your involvement and collaboration for the success of your child. Let us know how we can best support you and your child/children, so that they can show up for school on time every day!
