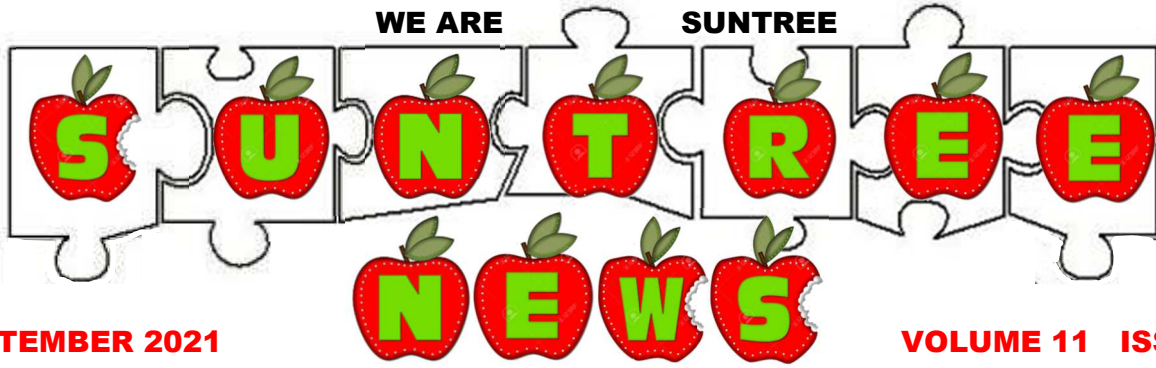

*Dear Suntree Families,*

*After a few challenges and many accomplishments, we are off to an amazing start this school year! As I walk through classrooms, I am so excited to see our students engaged and eager to learn. We appreciate your support and encouragement in helping to make the school day a successful experience for your child.*

*I want to remind you about the drop-off shelf located outside the front office. If you need to bring something to your child, please place it on the shelf and e-mail your child's teacher that the item is ready for pick-up. It is not necessary to drop off water bottles, lunch, or homework. We have bottled water available, lunch is free for all students, and homework can wait until the next day to be turned in. Our goal is to reduce the number of people in the front office.*

*Please remember that all medications (including over the counter meds) must be kept in the clinic. Cough drops, Tylenol, etc. must be brought to school by a parent/guardian in the original, unopened container, signed in with the nurse and picked up after 10 days. All prescription meds must have a form on file signed by the doctor. We appreciate your cooperation!*

*The tardy bell rings at 8:00am - please make every effort to get your child to school on time. In addition to missing valuable instruction time, late arrivals disrupt learning. Be it an appointment or an important family matter, we realize occasionally your child will need to be picked up early. Please remember, there are no dismissals after 2:00pm/12:45pm on Fridays. You must e-mail the teacher and front office - changes cannot be made over the phone.*

*Even though we are still treading through unknown waters, we know parents, students and staff working together will make the 2021-22 school year a successful experience for our students. We appreciate your flexibility and understanding.*

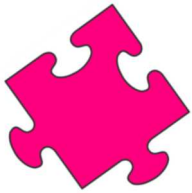
