Our Science Research students are competing in the Intracoastal Science and Engineering Fair on Thursday, February 6<sup>th</sup>, and we are excited and proud of their accomplishments as well as what their projects hold for future studies. Several of our students competed in All-County Band, Chorus and Orchestra. The performances were nothing short of outstanding, and our Edgewood musicians are now gearing up for their Musical Performance Assessments [MPA]. Edgewood's Visual Artists are earning awards in all facets of the Scholastic Art Competition with 13 regional winners and 4 gold keys. Our students earning a gold key will be considered for awards at the national level.

The Edgewood Thespians are excited to announce their very first performance on Edgewood's Black Box Stage. Yes, our students will be performing Shakespeare's Macbeth at Edgewood on March 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. Additionally, Team 9013 Merritt Island Matrix – one of our Robotics Programs – finished their season earning both the Motivate Award and the Promote Award. Team 801 Horsepower is now in full swing with their first tournament in mid-March.

Edgewood's student athletes had been working very hard and have had some stellar performances. Our boys and girls soccer teams had an outstanding season; our Girls Varsity Soccer team lost only twice on the season and did very well in districts. Our Boys Varsity Soccer team is competing for the District Championship against Holy Trinity on February 7<sup>th</sup>. Our Girls Basketball programs picked up wins against Satellite and MICS on senior night, and our Boys Basketball programs are moving into Districts, securing wins against MICS, Space Coast and others. The Arrowettes, Edgewood's Dance Team, also earned first place in their competitions. Go Edgewood!
