Our Advanced Jazz Band participated in the Jazz MPA on February 13th at Satellite High School. They received an overall rating of superior (1), including straight A's from 2 of the 3 judges.

On Friday, March 14th and Saturday, March 15th during the solo and ensemble MPA event at Viera High School, we had 27 solo and 4 ensemble entries - a total of 43 Edgewood Band students participating.
