Section 2 - Statement of Understanding:

It is strongly recommended that all students seek to develop both their mind and body to the greatest extent possible. Daily classes of physical education are essential for middle school students so they can learn and practice a healthy lifestyle. Therefore, the School Board of Brevard County requires all 7th and 8th grade students participate in a daily physical education class. However, per Senate Bill 610, a waiver may be requested for the following reasons:

1. Student is enrolled or required to enroll in a remedial course.

 - The student enroll in another course from among those offered as options by the school district **OR**
 - The student is participating in physical activities outside the school day which are equal to or in excess of the mandated requirement (75 hours per semester).
