

Instructions to apply for Cambridge @ Johnson Middle School

We are very happy you are interested in applying to the Cambridge program here at Johnson Middle School! Just follow these quick and easy steps:

1. Visit the [BPS Homepage](#) and click on Parents & Students at the top.
2. Find and select Family Dashboard.
3. Create an account for your child. You will need to upload proof of residency.
4. For a program, select the Cambridge Program at Johnson Middle School. Throughout this process, it will talk about a \$30 cost. This cost applies *ONLY* if you are NOT zoned for Johnson Middle School! If you **are zoned** for Johnson, you will not be charged.
5. Once step 4 is completed, we will be able to see your application.
6. We need several documents to complete your application.
 - a. 6th grade report card, a copy of the most recent one
 - b. FSA scores from 5th grade
 - c. 2 Teacher Recommendation Forms, including the current math teacher (teachers will send the completed forms to us - please provide blank forms to your student's teachers)
 - d. Handwritten essay on the topic: "Explain why you want to participate in this international program, include information about your career goals and future educational plans."
7. Now you have a choice!
 - a. Drop off copies of the documents at the Johnson Middle School front office, care of Sandy Dahl.
 - b. Give copies of the documents to your 6th grade teacher to send via BPS courier to Sandy Dahl @ Johnson.
 - c. Upload documents to the Family Dashboard. Email Sandy Dahl at Dahl.Sandy@brevardschools.org to let her know the documents are available.
 - d. Email the documents to Sandy Dahl at Dahl.Sandy@brevardschools.org
8. The deadline for applications is **February 28, 2020**. After reviewing all of the applications we receive, we will notify students of our acceptance decisions starting on March 23, 2020.
