

Cambridge 2020-21 Supply List (Pandemic Edition)

Supplies to be turned in to your Math teacher:

- 6-8 rolls of Scotch tape
- 1 large roll of paper towels (*7th grade only*)
- 1 family size box of tissues (*8th grade only*)
- 1 box of zip-lock type bags (quart or gallon size) (*7th graders only*)
- 1 pack of **lined** 4x6 index cards (or larger) (*8th grade only*)
- Cleaning wipes *if available* (*7th graders only*)
- Bottle of Hand Sanitizer *if available* (not mini) (*8th graders only*)

Supplies for student to keep:

- 12 spiral notebooks (70 – 90 pages, one subject) for use all year
- 3"- 4" three-ring binder (AVID Schoolwide)
- Loose leaf notebook paper
- 1 pkg. Crayola colored pencils (at least 12)
- 1 pkg. thin markers
- 1 or 2 fine point black Sharpies
- pens and #2 pencils and a pencil sharpener (Keep lots at home for replenishing during the year!)
- 1 pkg. notebook divider tabs
- 1 highlighter
- Ruler (6-inch or 12-inch)
- roll of tape
- scissors
- **earbuds**
- scientific calculator such as the TI-30Xa
- Post-it notes (various colors)

Teacher Wish List (totally optional!):

- Expo dry erase markers – any color
- Pencils
- Post-it notes (various sizes)
- Sharpies

Important things to know about the Cambridge program supplies:

- It will be imperative to eliminate the sharing of supplies during this pandemic. So, we have changed our normal practice, and are asking students to **CARRY** items such as colored pencils and markers with them every day.
- Items that are to be turned in to the History teachers are then distributed to the Cambridge classrooms (English, math, social studies, science). You will NOT be asked to replenish any of these items.
- Items that are kept by the student must be maintained and labeled with name throughout the year. For example, a student will need to purchase additional pencils as needed and have them available to use at all times. This is especially important now, as we do not want to be passing items to students or between students.
- Why so many notebooks and rolls of tape? Students typically use about 4 spiral notebooks per Cambridge class per year, and items get taped into the notebooks.
- Students may have elective classes that require certain supplies. These would be in addition to those required for Cambridge.
- The binder is required for Johnson, not just Cambridge, as we become AVID Schoolwide. It is the only binder your child should need.
- ALL math classes will be using a scientific calculator such as the TI-30Xa (approx. \$10 - \$15). *Purchasing a calculator is required.* **Put name on calculator!** They all look the same!
- Geometry students only: please do not purchase supplies for Geometry before this is discussed in class.
