## Cambridge 2023-24 Supply List

## Please note that the Cambridge supply list is in addition to the school-wide supply list

## Supplies to be turned in to your Math teacher:

- 1 pkg. Crayola colored pencils (at least 12)
- 1 pkg. 100 count sheet protectors
- 2 pkg . loose leaf notebook paper (college ruled)
- 1 pack of lined $3 \times 5$ index cards (7th grade only)
- 1 pack of graph $3 \times 5$ index cards ( 8 th grade only)
- 6-8 rolls of Scotch tape (7th grade only)
- 1 large roll of paper towels (7th grade only)
- 1 box of tissue ( $8^{\text {th }}$ graders only)
- 2-4 glue sticks ( $8^{\text {th }}$ graders only)

Supplies for student to keep and bring to school:

- 1 or 2 fine point black sharpies
- pens and \#2 pencils (Keep lots at home for replenishing during the year!)
- wired earbuds
- scientific calculator (TI-30Xa) for use at home
- Post-it notes (various colors)

Teacher Wish List (totally optional!):

- Hand sanitizing wipes or cleaning wipes
- Expo dry erase markers - any color
- Pencils and/or pens
- Post-it notes (various sizes)
- Erasable pens (math class)
- Black Sharpies
- Colored Sharpies


## Important things to know about the Cambridge program

 supplies:- Items that are to be turned in to the Math teachers are then distributed to the Cambridge classrooms (English, math, social studies, science) for students to access throughout the year. You will NOT be asked to replenish any of these items. This keeps families from having to purchase supplies later in the year when they are more expensive, and the supplies will be at school when and where students need them.
- Items that are to be kept by the student must be maintained throughout the year. For example, a student will need to purchase additional pencils as needed and have them available to use at all times.
- Students may borrow class supplies, such as glue sticks, colored pencils or markers, to use at home as needed.
- Students may have elective classes that require certain supplies. These would be in addition to those required for Cambridge.
- The binder is required for Johnson, not just Cambridge, as we become AVID Schoolwide. It is the only binder your child should need.
- ALL math classes will be using the scientific calculator TI-30Xa (approx. \$10-\$15).
- Geometry students only: please do not purchase supplies for Geometry before this is discussed in class.
