Thank you for your interest in the Gifted Advanced Placement Preparation (GAPP) program at Southwest. The program is designed to meet the special needs of academically talented students. Each student will be exposed to increased rigor within each class. The program is designed to provide a seamless entry into high school advanced placement programs, as well as specialized academics that enhance students' critical and creative thinking abilities.

The 7th Grade GAPP program has sixty-six seats available for the 2023-2024 school year. A team of teachers that hold or are completing their Gifted Certification will loop with the 7th and 8th grade students each year to provide an academically challenging curriculum while fostering strong, positive interpersonal relationships among students and teachers, which in turn, will increase learning opportunities for students.

Please review with your child, **all** of the information in this packet. The successful GAPP student is personally motivated to excel in a challenging program and contribute to a diverse and dynamic community of learners. If your student's homeschool is not Southwest Middle School, you must complete an Educational Location Option (ELO) by February 24th. The ELO application can be found on the district web site under the parent tab.

All new applicants should return their completed applications, with their registration form, handwritten essay and parent recommendation form to Southwest Middle school by **4:00 PM on Monday, March 27, 2023**. ***Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.***

Final decisions for acceptance will be made by **April 7, 2023**. All students who have been accepted into the GAPP program will receive an acceptance letter.
