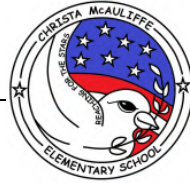

Kindergarten-5th Grade Computer & Materials Return

School computers, chargers, textbooks, library books, and any other materials belonging to the school or teacher, will need to be returned **Tuesday, June 1st – Thursday, June 3rd from 9:00-12:00PM** in the front office. At this time, you will also receive your eLearning student's report card.

Please do not return materials between 12:00-2:00PM as we will be dismissing students at that time and can not hold up the car loop to receive materials.

Please bring all school materials to the front office for check in. It is very important that you **don't forget the laptop chargers**. You will be required to sign-in the computers and notify us of any issues with the computers or chargers (broken screens, charging problems, program issues, etc.).

6th Grade Computer, Materials Return & Awards

On **Tuesday, June 1st at 3:00PM**, there will be a virtual celebration/awards recognition and farewell message from the 6th grade teachers. The link will be provided on the student's Google classroom, closer to the date. Parents will also receive a message from their teacher on their Class Dojo App with information.

On **Wednesday, June 2nd from 2:00-3:00PM**, 6th grade eLearning students will go through the **CAR LOOP first**, to drop off school computers, chargers, the TCI World History textbook, the Math hardcover textbook, Freedom Walkers book, A Wrinkle in Time book and any outstanding library books (if not dropped off already).

Students will then proceed to the **BUS LOOP** for a celebration, awards and there they will receive their report cards from the 6th grade teachers.

Brick and mortar students will receive their awards and report cards during the regular school day on Wednesday, June 2nd. (Unfortunately, due to COVID, there will not be an awards ceremony this year) If any brick and mortar students would like to attend the drive through on 6/2, they must make arrangements ahead of time with their homeroom teacher.

2021-2022 Registration Day and Address Verification

Registration will take place on **Thursday, July 15th from 8:00AM-4:00PM** in the cafeteria and is mandatory for all students (even if we've already received completed a registration packet). At this time, we will have you verify all of the information provide in the registration packet, set transportation for your child and you will receive your child's teacher placement.

All students attending McAuliffe Elementary are required to provide documentation to prove residency in our district. To shorten the registration day process, you may complete the address verification any-time Monday, June 14th through Wednesday, July 14th from 7:30AM-3:00PM in the front office. To complete address verification, the parent or guardian who signed the registration form will need to provide 2 proofs of residence. One document from each tier must be provided as proof of residence (documents must list the name of the registering parent or guardian)

Tier 1:

Current driver's license
Current Homestead exemption
Purchase contract
Lease/rental agreement

Tier 2:

Current utility statement (within 30-45 days)
FL voters' registration card
Medical or health card (with address listed)
Homeowners insurance policy or bill
Auto insurance policy or bill
