



#### Q2 What is your child's current grade level?





#### Q3 Does your child have access to a computer and internet connection outside of school?






# Q5 Does your child's school keep you informed about information and events in a format that is easy to understand?





#### Q7 Do you feel welcome at your child's school?









#### Q10 Do you feel your child's school values input from families?





#### Q12 What is the best way for you to provide input regarding your child's school?



### Q13 In what ways can family engagement be strengthened at your child's school?



#### Q14 How often do you communicate with your child's teachers?





### Q15 Are you aware of what your child is expected to master in all subject areas?





# Q16 How often does your child's teacher communicate with you about your child's progress?





# Q17 How many times per month do you access your child's grades through FOCUS?





# Q18 How often do you have conversations with your child about what he or she is learning in school?





### Q19 How often do you work with your child on homework or class assignments?





# Q20 In the past year, how often have you participated in classroom activities during the school day?








