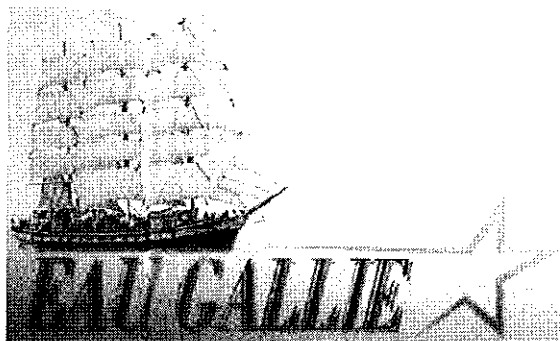

School and Community

Eau Gallie High School is located in Melbourne, Florida in Brevard County; an emerging technological center that boasts a variety of cultural and social opportunities. The population of the city of Melbourne was 80,127 as of 2015. It is strategically located midway between Jacksonville and Miami, approximately 60 miles southeast of Orlando on Florida's East Coast.

Eau Gallie High School is one of sixteen high schools in the Brevard County School System. Nestled into 35 acres, Eau Gallie High School has a student population that includes 42% socio-economically disadvantaged, 34% minority, 17% exceptional education students (non-gifted), 10% gifted, 4% English Language Learners (ELL) and a 14% Hispanic Population. The school's current student enrollment stands at approximately 1,648.

Curriculum

Eau Gallie High School offers a comprehensive curriculum in exceptional, basic, regular, honors and college level coursework. Classes meet five times per week for 47 minutes per day. Eau Gallie High School operates under a seven period per day schedule. Credit requirements for graduation include:

Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Program, Collegiate High School, Advancement through Individual Determination (AVID), Dual Enrollment, and Early Admission programs are available to students who have demonstrated the readiness to pursue college level work while still in high school.

AICE is a rigorous, internationally recognized pre-university curriculum and examination program designed for highly motivated, academically able students in grades 9-12. The AICE program of study is written and administered throughout the world by Cambridge International Examinations (CIE), a non-profit department of the University of Cambridge in England. Eau Gallie High School currently offers the following AICE coursework: English Language/Literature, Thinking Skills, General Paper, European History, U.S. History, Media Studies, Psychology, Biology, Environmental, Marine, Physics, Spanish, Music and Art.

AVID is a college preparatory program that is designed to assist high school students to prepare for and succeed in college. Students participate in a rigorous program of instruction in academic “survival skills.” Students are expected to enroll in advanced/college preparatory coursework in order to enhance their success at the collegiate level. Eau Gallie High School is a Demonstration School for the National AVID Program.

Eau Gallie High School offers Collegiate High School; a program for high school students ready for a head start toward college. Participants spend part of the school day at Eastern Florida State College, taking college level coursework while still in high school. Upon graduation, students receive both a high school diploma and an Associates Degree. We currently have 54 students participating in this program.

Grading and Ranking Procedures

Eau Gallie High School assigns letter grades using a 4.0 system. Class rank is reported on the transcript and determined by a students cumulative, unweighted GPA. Upon request, rank in class using academic subjects may be calculated on a weighted basis.
