

EFSC Summer Term News

Walk-in Registration for the 2019 Summer Term opens on Monday, March 25, 2019.

Students may make a registration appointment for March 25 or thereafter by using the online appointment tool, which will be available on February 23, or they may meet with an advisor without an appointment.

Please be aware that classes with low enrollment may be cancelled before the first day of the term due to financial considerations. If a class is cancelled, the college will notify the student by phone and request that the student contact an EFSC advisor. Advisors will be available to assist the student with other options if the registration form provides sufficient flexibility. In some cases, the same course may be available at a different time, different campus, or even offered via Eastern Florida Online and the problem may be resolved.

EFSC advisors will also alert students when they register regarding possible class cancellations and stress the importance of contacting the college if they receive this notification.

This procedural change is in effect for the summer term only. Dual enrollment and collegiate high school students will again be able to schedule an early registration appointment for the fall term beginning Saturday, March 23. Students with an appointment can register for fall classes beginning Monday, April 22. Walk-in registration opens on Monday, May 6.
