Academic Integrity Policy (3-6)

Expectations of all PYP Students

Accept responsibility for own academic actions: I will demonstrate integrity in research, projects, documents, and homework by not copying the work of others and presenting it as my own. Out of respect and fairness, I will not use the words/work of others without their permission or acknowledgement. I will accept assistance from others, but not allow another to share answers or do MY work for me. I will submit my own ideas and work for all assignments.

Assignments, Projects, and Presentations will reflect my ‘personal best’: This means I will do the best work I can, whether I am working independently or cooperatively, learning from and sharing knowledge with others. I will continue to learn and grow, as best I can, by striving to be a student of academic integrity presenting with confidence, my own work.

All assignments (i.e., quizzes, tests, projects, assessments) I complete, will be done with honesty and integrity, following the explicit guidelines of my teacher. Adhering to these guidelines will build trust with my learning community. I understand that transgressions against these policies will lead to a loss of trust and more formal consequences.
