Recruitment Award for Math, Science and Computer Science Teachers

The 2019 legislative changes amended s. 1012.731, F.S., The Florida Best and Brightest Teacher Program, s. 1012.732, F.S., The Florida Best and Brightest Principal Program. Part of the changes to the program was to create a one-time recruitment award for content experts in math, science or computer science. As defined by Rule 6AER19-01 a content expert is defined by the following criteria:

- Hold a valid Florida teaching certificate with one of the following certification areas: Math, Science or Computer Science
- Has either:
 - o Earned at least a master's degree in the areas of mathematics, science, or computer science from an accredited institution; **OR**
 - Earned at least a bachelor's degree in the areas of mathematics, science, or computer science from an accredited institution and who has at least 5 years' teaching experiences in the associated subject area or at least 5 years' work experiences in the associated subject area.
