


CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

CTE classes can be taken to enhance the high school curriculum and provide a wide range of experiences and preparedness for post high school education and careers.

Every CTE class offers a certification upon completion of course work and/or certification exam by the third year. Some satisfy the practical arts requirement.



Each CTE course can qualify for the Gold Seal Vocational Scholarship.

In Automotive I, II, III students develop skills in equipment and safety regulations, O.S.H.A. and material M.S.D.S.'s along with employability skills. Students will be taught tools identification and proper tool usage along with correct shop procedures in minor repairs. Upon completion of the program, students are prepared for entry level positions. The Satellite automotive students have won many awards over the years.

The Administrative Office Specialist program includes Digital Information Technology, and Business Software Applications I and II. 

The Fashion Technology and Design Services Program is designed to teach students advanced sewing skills while constructing accessories and garments through a sequence of courses. The purpose of this program is to offer a career track option that will prepare students for entry-level employment position or continued study in the Fashion industry. In a labtype environment, students learn to operate and maintain equipment such as sergers, embroidery machines, an industrial hemmer and more.

The purpose of this program is to prepare students for work as multimedia artists and designers. The content includes but is not limited to practical experiences in photography, graphic design, interactive presentation development, testing and production. Specialized skills in multimedia presentations and authoring software produce a variety of multimedia projects.



Tech Design I, II, and III prepares students to create 2 dimensional technical drawings, illustrations and 3D models. Students design and create three-dimensional objects and projects using on-site 3D printers and a professional laser cutter. Students are also introduced to various disciplines of design such as mechanical, architecture, structural, and landscape design. Students will learn how to use the 3 AutoDesk programs to assist in the design process.



SATELLITE ACADEMY OF FINE ARTS

In addition to the CTE program, Satellite High School also offers The Satellite Academy of Fine Arts (SAFA), a small personalized learning community within Satellite High School. SAFA draws on the students' interest in learning about the arts, and integrates arts-specific curriculum and instruction into the core academic curriculum. In other words, students in the academy get the benefit and experience of learning how the fine arts connect to their English and social science classes. We find that this keeps students with a high interest in the arts engaged in their core curriculum. In addition to their core curriculum, students have access to one of the highest-achieving and the most diverse set of fine arts course offerings anywhere in the state. Some of the courses available within the CTE program also qualify students for SAFA.
