Auditions are held for program placement and include:

- **Theatre** Two prepared contrasting one-minute monologues, cold reading or improvisation, and an interview.
- **Vocal Music** One prepared selection (Either art or Broadway show song), sight-reading, scales, and an interview.
- **Instrumental Music** Melodic and rhythmic prepared selections, scales (4 sharps and 4 flats), sight-reading, and an interview.

Satellite Academy of Fine Arts (SAFA)

- The Satellite Academy of Fine Arts (SAFA) encourages the development of aesthetic, analytical, interpersonal, creative, and performance skills of students at <u>all</u> levels. This Choice Program is academically challenging and performance/technologically sound, as well as college and career driven.
- The Satellite Academy of Fine Arts has seven areas of focus: instrumental music, vocal music, theater, visual art, digital media, web development & design, and technical design. The three CTE SAFA programs provides opportunities for students to earn industry certification that can be used for employment or post-secondary educational opportunities.
- The program provides a relevant and rigorous curriculum to prepare students for the 21st-century arts community workplace as well as post-secondary opportunities. Through integration, students see relativity and form connections between art, music, literature, history, and more.
- Enrollment in the Satellite Academy of Fine Arts is based on student and parent completion of the application and an audition/interview. Out-of-Zone students will additionally need placement through the Educational Program Opportunities, which is a lottery-based system.
- Entry based on the EPO SAFA Program Application requires a 3-4 year commitment and is open to rising 9th and 10th grade students only if **not offered** at their zoned school of attendance.

General SAFA Requirements:

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA in fine art concentration, and an overall 2.5 GPA.
- Enroll in SAFA English, World History, and US History Honors courses. Eligible SAFA students may replace these courses with Advanced Placement or Dual Enrollment courses.
- Earn 100 hours of Community Service by end of the senior year (15 hours each semester).
- Students must complete their fine art concentration program requirements, including the Senior Year Project, as outlined in the SAFA Program Requirements brochure on the school website.
- Annual student and parent meeting with Academy Director to review SAFA requirements.

Students must adhere to all district/school attendance and discipline policies.
