Good evening Longhorns,

Track season begins September 21st. In order to be a member of the Longhorn Track Team and participate in track season this year students must return a completed physical packet to Coach Langlie in room 912 by this Friday, September 18th. Physical packets are available for pick up in the front office.

If a student is being checked out, it is encouraged to have the student bring a note to the front office or have a parent call the front office before 9:30am.

If a student is feeling ill, a request to see the clinic nurse is advised. If the student requires a pick up, the parent will be contacted. If someone other than the registering parent/guardian is picking up the student, the school is required to contact the registering parent/guardian prior to releasing the student. Please refer to the Johnson Middle School Student Handbook for additional information regarding the Check-Out Policy.

This is an e-Learning instructional method clarification:

Before a student can be an e-Learner, an e-Learning Agreement must be signed and submitted to the front office. The choice to be an e-Learner is to minimize exposure, therefore alternating between brick and mortar and e-learning is not advised. For example: A Student should not be an e-learner Monday, Wednesday and Friday and a brick and mortar student Tuesday and Thursday. It is important to select the best instructional choice for the student and family and maintain consistency. If you plan to change the student's instructional method, it is necessary to contact the front office or school counselor.
