

Just lost your **health insurance**?

You may be able to sign up for **health insurance** with a Special Enrollment Period.

What is a Special Enrollment Period?

A Special Enrollment Period is a time, other than Open Enrollment, when you can sign up for health insurance through [healthcare.gov](https://www.healthcare.gov). You have 60 days to apply after you lose your existing health coverage.



How much will the insurance cost?

- The cost depends on your annual income projection, not your current income. Unemployment benefits count.
- Nearly 90% of people qualify for financial help.
- Some plans are available with a zero monthly cost.

How can I get free local help?



Licensed, federally certified navigators are available.
