

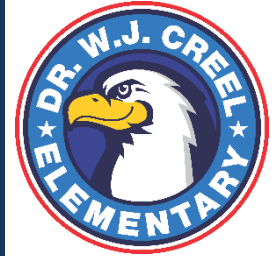

<b>Communication: Stay Informed</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Communicate with families regularly using a variety of methods such as: Focus, conferences, student planner, phone calls, emails, school sign, Peachjar, School Facebook Page, Blackboard Connect, administration bi-weekly email, text messages and the Creel Chronicle newsletter</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Check my child's backpack and/or school planner each day for daily work, notifications and homework assignments</li> <li>Provide ongoing communication and support to my child's teachers and administration via, conferencing, phone calls, emails and by signing the student planner</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Give all notices, letters, and/or school planner to my parents or a responsible adult every day</li> <li>Have my parent sign my planner every day</li> </ul>
<b>Learning Environment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provide a supportive, effective and safe learning environment</li> <li>Provide opportunities, experiences and lessons on how to be safe, responsible and respectful citizens</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provide an appropriate bedtime and a quiet place for homework</li> <li>Read to or with my child every night</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Work cooperatively at school, follow school and bus rules, care for supplies and materials, and be courteous and respectful to other students and staff</li> </ul>
