In the Media Center

In Media news, students are now checking out books on a weekly basis during their Media activity time. Please make sure students bring their books back to school each week so they can trade them out for new books!

Be on the lookout for information on our optional reading program for students in 3rd-6th grade! Students will be challenged to read 15 Sunshine State Young Reader Award (SSYRA) books in grades 3-5 and 14 books in 6th grade! These books were nominated for the SSYRA by the Florida Association of Media in Education. More information, including a list and summaries of the books will be coming home with you students soon! Students that read at least 10 of these books will be invited to attend SLAM, a fun filled day where we play trivia and participate in Makerspace activities based on the SSYRA books.

Students in kindergarten, first, and second grades will read the Sunshine State Jr. books during their Media class. A list of these books along with a summary will be coming home soon!

Students in our 6th grade classes will be working on a course as part of the Career and Technical Education (CTE) program. The course is called ICT Fundamentals and the curriculum has four parts:

Demonstrate foundation skills using word processing and spreadsheet applications

Fundamental knowledge of computer skills

Communication fundamentals

Demonstrate foundational skills of cybersecurity (internet safety, security, and cyberbullying)

This course will be completed during Media activity time each week and we are beginning with learning about word processing (Microsoft Word and Google Docs). Students in younger grades will also be learning all about word processing to help prepare them for the course in 6th grade.

Assessments

The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is a progress monitoring tool that will be administered three times per year to track your student's progress in learning the Benchmarks of Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards throughout this school year. Your student's results from PM 1 are for informational purposes only, and your student's school will provide you with information about how to access the results after testing is completed.

Students in Kindergarten through first grade will take Renaissance Star Early Literacy and Star Math assessments on September 12th and 13th. Students in grade 2 will take Renaissance Star Reading, and Star Math assessments.

FAST assessments are computer-adaptive tests taken on a computer or tablet. The questions get easier or more difficult depending

on how the student responds, and each student will see different questions. If you or your student would like to review Star Early Literacy or Star Math sample items at home, sample test items are available at https://fl-fast.org/resources/renaissance-star/renaissance-star.

Students in grades 3-6 will take the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) Reading assessments on September 6th and the Mathematics assessment on September 7th.


