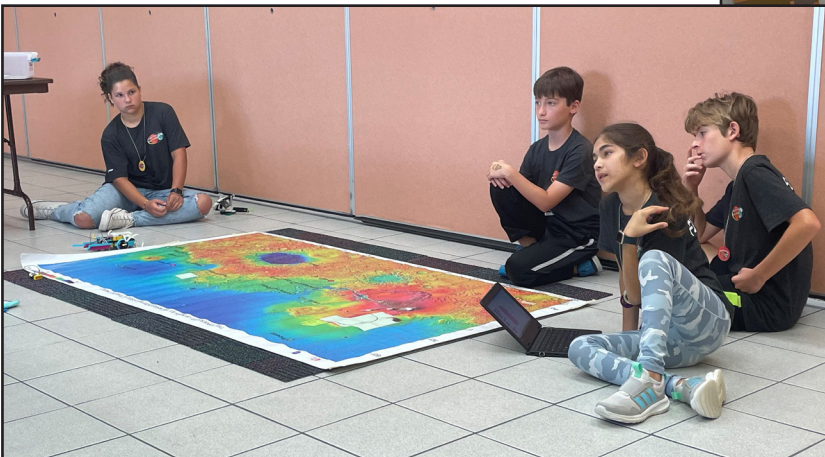
If you do not complete a renewal application your student will have to go to their zoned school for the 2023-2024 school year

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Summer Voluntary Prekindergarten

**Join us for a summer of fun, learning and building
a foundation for school success!**

Brevard Public Schools is offering a FREE Summer VPK program to children who are 4-years-old on or before September 1, 2022, reside in Florida, and have not attended the School Year VPK program.

Step 1

Parents must visit the Early Learning Coalition website at www.elcbrevard.org to complete the on-line registration process to obtain a VPK Certificate of Eligibility. Please contact the Early Learning Coalition at (321) 637-1800 for additional information.

Step 2

Parents may enroll at the Summer VPK school listed below beginning May 1, 2023.

For school enrollment, parents must bring:

- VPK Certificate of Eligibility
- Child's original birth certificate
- Immunization records
- Current physical examination
- Two (2) forms of residence verification

Program Information

Summer VPK will be held May 31 – July 25, 2023.

A Meet & Greet will be hosted on May 31 from 11:30 – 3:30.

June 1 – July 25 will be full school days from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm.

There will be no school on July 3 & 4.

Individual Education Plan (IEP) services will not be provided during the summer.

Parents must provide transportation. Breakfast and lunch will be available.
