Updates to the Re-Opening Plan:

- We have exciting news! We are able to re-open our playgrounds on Monday, November 2nd. We have developed a plan to ensure cleaning of equipment and handwashing/sanitizing before and after use.
- The schoolboard voted to amend the language of the face covering section of the reopening plan. Effective immediately, all faculty and students are only permitted to use a face shield, in lieu of a mask, when the instruction requires the ability to see the face of the student and/or the teacher or with an applicable exemption. If you choose to wear a face shield you must have a mask as well.
