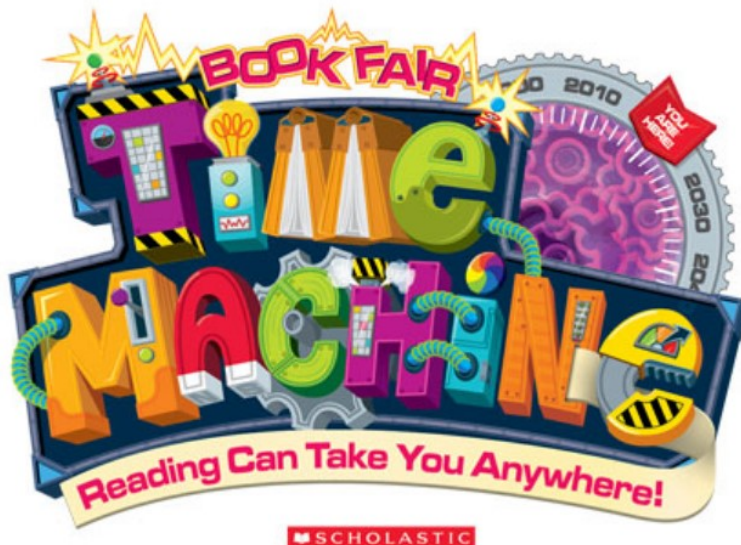

TK-1/Kindergarten

This week, some of our Kindergarten classes are learning All About Me! We will be celebrating our differences within our school family!
