- Impact Aid is funding from the Fed. Gov. for property tax that has been removed from the tax rolls (federal property like military housing, etc)
- Our District generates \$500,000+ in impact aid annually.
- Impact Aid funds are used for school support, maintenance, and construction.

TK-1/Kindergarten

We had fun learning about the things that make us the same and different. We reviewed our data and the things that make each of us unique. Most of our kindergarten classes have been learning about and discussing "Our Five Senses". We are discovering our five senses and learning how much we use our senses every day. Many of our classes are using apples, popcorn or other foods to explore the five senses. At the end of this unit, your child should be able to tell you all five senses and the purpose of each of them.

We had a really exciting week in the Media Center. Students received their "library card" and checked out their first book! 1st and 2nd grade students were able to take their book home. Kindergarten students kept their book in the classroom this week and will be able to bring it home next week.

We talked about taking care of our library books. Kindergarten students read "Mr. Wiggle's Book". 1st grade read "What Happened to Marions Book?" and 2nd read "The Jacket". Everyone had a smile on their face and proudly left with a book. It was a fun week in the media center!

School Counselor's Corner- Mrs. McLean

October starts this week! Wow! Can you believe it? October is deemed National Bully Prevention Month. This year we will be using the Second Step Bully Prevention Curriculum to teach our students how to recognize, report, and refuse bullying. These lessons begin on October 12th for our 2nd Graders and October 19th for Kindergarteners and 1st Graders. Stay tuned for the parent letter with information to access resources to reinforce these lessons at home.

This week we continue to teach Skills for Learning. Kindergarteners and 1st Graders are learning, Following Directions while our 2nd Graders are learning, Using Self-Talk. I hope you are enjoying using the home link with your students.

1st

Wow! Can you believe it is already the middle of the first nine weeks. We have been busy, busy in first grade growing our brains. A successful classroom community is important to our first grade because classroom communities promote positive social interactions and increased academic achievement.

In reading we are continuing to work on retelling a story using the words first, then, next, after that, and last. Students should be able to tell and describe both the characters and the setting of a story. Very soon we will begin our study of non-fiction. During this time students will be working with text features such as: photographs, captions, headings, table of contents, glossary, index, maps, and keywords to help them access and understand various non-fiction topics.

Finally in math we are continuing to work on addition with number bonds. We have begun working with equalities such as $2+4=1+5$. We have also been learning about missing addends and how to solve for them by counting on.

2nd

Second grade has been working hard this first half of the nine weeks! E-learners have been busy learning to submit assignments on Google Slides as well as attending small groups in Zoom! Brick and Mortar learners have been enjoying socially distance learning activities!

Second grade just finished with measurement in Eureka Math and are moving on to place value. Everyone has been working so hard on their Math skills. In reading, students have been learning about main ideas and details in both informational and fiction texts. The year has really gotten underway, and our second graders are working so hard!
