Picture retake day is DECEMBER 4th! Students who will need to get their pictures taken on DECEMBER 4th are:

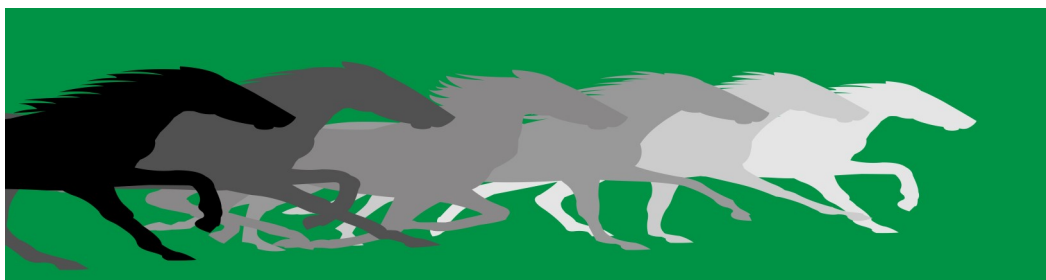
- Students who were quarantined on the first picture day.

First grade has finished the Module 2 Mid-Module Assessment in math! We have been working on making 10 to help us solve addition problems. We practiced making 10 when an addend is 9, 8, or 7, using the commutative property to make 10, and solving word problems with three addends (two of which made 10). We will continue with Module 2, and will be focusing on making ten, taking away from 10, and subtracting 9 and 10 from teen numbers.

In reading, we are working on making connections between characters and events in informational text and distinguishing between information found in pictures/illustrations and information found in the words in an informational text.

Please continue to read at home with your child and practice the high frequency words on a regular basis. Thank you for all your home support!
